Example - miserable.


Challenge - Once you have thought of 5 adjectives, see if you can put them into sentences.

Maths -

On Monday we began looked at how a number is made up of tens and ones.

In order for us to be able to count bigger numbers we need to group things into ten so we don't need to count all the ones individually.



Here we have 2 groups of 10 which = 20 and 7 individual pencils. As we learnt on Monday, the 7 takes the 0's place to go into the ones column meaning we have 27 pencils.
