Curriculum Information Y4 – Term 1, 2023

Our key focus is 'Cohesion' this term.

English

We will be looking at different styles of writing through 'The Write Stuff' approach. Our focus will be poetry and narrative (stories). We will also be writing letters and information texts through our topic learning.

Please encourage your child to read a wide range of texts to give them ideas for their own writing in school. Please encourage your child to practise reading and spelling the 'Common Exception Words' at home and to read five times per week.

Maths

The focus will be place value (including 4-digit numbers and negative numbers) alongside calculations using + - x and ÷. We will also be practising times tables with a weekly 'beat the clock' speed recall session. Please help your child at home by practising their tables, and involving them in 'everyday' maths such as cooking, measuring, time and money.

Science - Sound

We will be learning about how sound is made, how sound travels and what happens to sound in different situations.

Geography - Rivers (The Water Cycle)

Our focus will be 'The Water Cycle' but we will link this to learning about rivers and the features of them.

Art and Design

We will be exploring cartoon drawing and illustrations. Children will design their own characters leading to making a 3D model.

Computing - Computer Networks



As well as using computers to create presentations, we will be learning about computer networks and the internet, including online safety.

Religious Education - Hinduism

We will learn about worship and festivals including key Hindu beliefs.

History - Vikings and Anglo Saxons

We will learn about significant events from this era and use chronology to put them in order.

PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education)

The focus will be learning about how we keep our bodies healthy through eating and exercise. We will explore sugar, salt and fat as well as the main food groups.

Music

We will be using the scheme 'Music Express' topic Ancient Worlds. Our focus will be musical structure.



Modern Foreign Languages - Spanish

We will be taking part in simple conversations, and begin to read and write these phrases.



P.E. – Gymnastics and Boxercise

Our visiting sports coaches will be leading sessions on
