

## Knowledge Organisers

These one-page, fully editable knowledge organisers have been put together to support teachers when introducing a topic to their pupils. All of the knowledge organisers work alongside Oddizzi's schemes of work, our pathway document and the year group vocabulary and glossary banks.

### Suggested Use

- Encourage prior research
- Discuss as a class at the beginning of a topic
- Stick into books to refer back to throughout the unit
- Display in the classroom for reference
- Set expectations for vocabulary to be used by pupils in their learning

Each organiser contains:

- A **summary** of what will be covered in each unit of study
- **Key Facts**
- **Key Knowledge**
- A **vocabulary list** split into three helpful categories: place names, geographical terms and processes, and locational terms
- Key **glossary terms** chosen from Oddizzi's Progression in Vocabulary document
- Pictures

Not all foodstuffs can be produced in a country with a temperate climate, such as the UK

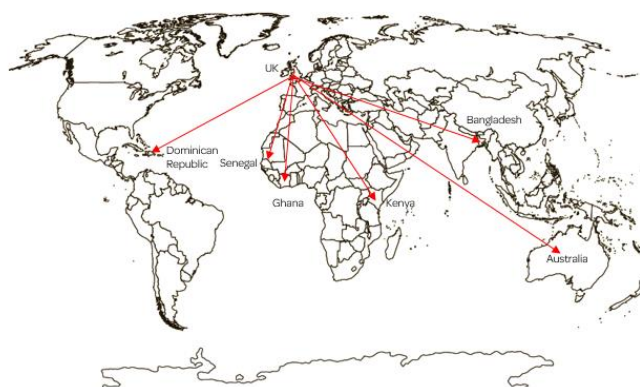
The Fairtrade mark guarantees a fair price for food production
